2023 ARRIVAL PROCESS

AECFV is the location of our Heart and Eye Clinic. They employ almost 90 individuals, and are committed to the livelihoods of those employees and the families they support. The clinic has implemented many measures to continue to be able to serve the community while still protecting their staff and doing their part to “flatten the curve” of COVID-19.

When you arrive, please present yourself to the check in desk where you will be provided with the next step in the process. A GRCBC Clinic Volunteer will take your dog from you to take into its eye exam and return the dog to you a few minutes later. Likely, the same process will be followed for heart appointments. Owners will again not be permitted into the actual examination appointment.

NO INFORMATION regarding your dog will be given to Christine or her volunteers, or clinic staff. CAER eye exam results will be completed online by the Eye Specialist and will be emailed to you soon after the exam. If the Eye Specialist wants to discuss her findings with you, she will come outside and discuss it with you privately. Same for Heart/Echo Exams.

If you are arriving late due to unforeseen circumstances, please take a breath, check in and make us aware you are running late. We will drop your dogs asap. We are all volunteers and ask that you be respectful and patient

How to register for an EYE EXAM: fill in the **EYE APPOINTMENT FORM** at the bottom of this flyer and email this page to me along with payment so that I have all your correct information. If sending a cheque, please email me this form and say your cheque is coming.

I WILL LET YOU KNOW ONCE I HAVE BOOKED DATES AND TIMES AND THEN YOU CAN GO to the OFA website register your dog for our clinic. **IF YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED ONLINE YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO HAVE YOUR DOG'S EYES EXAMINED. PLEASE DO NOT REGISTER YOUR DOG UNTIL I HAVE LET YOU KNOW WHETHER IT IS SATURDAY OR SUNDAY.**

Fill in an application form for your dog(s) (create a new application) and choose "health clinic". You can then go to the month of May and click on the Langley Clinic on May 6th, 2023, then create form. Please bring a copy of your form to the Clinic. An online application MUST be filled out prior to attending the clinic.

How to register for an AUSCULTATION ONLY heart exam: fill in the **AUSCULTATION ONLY APPOINTMENT FORM** at the bottom of this flyer and email this page to me along with payment so that I have all your correct information. If sending a cheque, please email me this form and say your cheque is coming.

THEN: Please go to the site <https://www.ofa.org/application-forms>

and download the BASIC CARDIAC FORM - complete the form with your dog's information and bring **TWO COPIES** to the clinic with you. PLEASE EMAIL ME A COPY OF YOUR DOG'S CARDIAC FORM ONCE YOU HAVE REGISTERED IT FOR THE CLINIC. DO NOT COMPLETE THE DATE ON THE FORM, OR THE DOCTOR'S INFO UNLESS IT AUTO-FILLS.

CLINIC ATTENDANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- ◆ All dogs for EYE appointments MUST be pre-registered on the OFA Online registration site FOR THE SAME DAY AS YOUR APPOINTMENT. It is imperative the dog is examined on the same day as it is registered online with OFA. Please bring a copy of the form for each dog who has an eye appointment and be prepared to hand it in with each dog when they go into the building. If your dog is not registered on the OFA Online site, you will not be able to have your dog's eyes examined. The volunteer identifying your dog will also need to see this form. **PLEASE ENSURE YOU ARE AVAILABLE TO HAVE YOUR DOG'S EYES DROPPED 30 MIN BEFORE YOUR APPT TIME.**
- ◆ All dogs for AUSCULTATION appointments MUST have TWO COPIES of the completed "Application for Basic Cardiac Database" form filled out and you will need to hand it in with each of your dog's when they go into the building to see the cardiac doctor. If you cannot provide a completed form, you will not be able to have your dog's heart examined. The volunteer identifying your dog will also need to see this form.
- ◆ All dogs for ECHO appointments will be provided with a triplicate form which I will have completed for you. You will receive the form at check in.
- ◆ **PARKING: UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD YOU PARK IN THE PARKING SPOTS IMMEDIATELY IN FRONT OF THE MAIN CLINIC ENTRANCE WHICH IS OPEN FOR EMERGENCY CLIENTS. THE CLINIC NEEDS THOSE SPOTS FOR CURBSIDE PICK UPS FOR DOGS IN CRISIS. ALSO, PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF BUSINESSES IN THE COMPLEX THAT ARE OPEN ON THE WEEKEND (EG GREENHAWK).**
- ◆ **ARRIVAL AT CLINIC:** Please leave your dogs in your car and go to the registration desk under the pop-up tent. At that time, you will be marked as arrived on the schedule and you will be given your Echo triplicate cardiac screening form (if you have an echo booked). You will also be given instructions on where to go for each of the eye and heart appointments. You will be directed to clinic volunteers who will go to your vehicle to verify your dog's identification and if you have an eye appointment, put drops in your dog's eyes.
- ◆ We have a lot of dogs coming and going and will be doing the best job we can to ensure you all can get your dog's clearances done in a timely manner.
- ◆ If your dogs have tattoos and not microchips, please ensure that the tattoo area has been clipped or shaved so that the tattoo is easily readable. If the tattoo is not readable, we will not be able to mark your dog as identified. We will need to see the copy of the appropriate screening form to match it up with each dog.

- ◆ You will be given appointment date and times prior to the clinic, by me. YOU are responsible for having your dog(s) at the appropriate door at the time of your appointment. Due to COVID restrictions, we will not be allowing people to line up and wait in line for appointments. Please wait in your vehicle until it is your time and then proceed to the correct door for your appointments.
- ◆ Once it is your appointment time, you will hand off your dog to a Club volunteer who will take your dog in to see the appropriate specialist. No owners are allowed to enter the building. If you only have one dog for an eye appointment, you will wait there for your dog to be returned back to you. If you have more than one dog, you will return to your vehicle to get your 2nd dog and then switch etc. The procedure will be followed for all of your dogs for both eye and heart appointments. If you are having Echo appointments, we ask that you wait at a good distance from the building so that we can avoid people gathering. In most cases, if you have more than one dog, their appointments are back-to-back.
- ◆ Please leave the parking lot immediately upon completion of your appointments to make room for the next people arriving.
- ◆ Some of the eye appointments are on a Sunday. If your dog is booked for eyes, please ensure you have picked the correct clinic day on the OFA Online site.
- ◆ Parking will be limited, but there are parking spots all around the complex. If you only have one or two dogs, please leave the spots close to the building available for the people who are bringing more than 3 dogs (there are quite a few of these people).

- ◆ The Clinic is open 24/7 so please respect staff who are working and clients/patients of the clinic.
- ◆ Please remember to ALWAYS pick up after your dogs. There is a bag dispenser and a garbage can in front of the main entrance to the clinic
- ◆ Hopefully, I have remembered everything and thank you for supporting our clinic. If you have any problems, please don't hesitate to come find me and I will solve the problem if I can.
- ◆ Please be appreciative to the volunteers who having given up their weekend to make this clinic available to you.
